Flickers, now in its third decade, produces video, audio and film about the arts for television, festivals and other non-profit organizations. Flickers creates and produces educational programs that teach about the media arts. From the acclaimed Rhode Island International Film Festival held each August to the Vortex Sci-Fi, Fantasy & Horror Film Festival held in October to Flickers' award-winning arts and cultural programming "Between Takes," to the 7DayPSA Competition, the Creative Impulse Awards to radio programming with "DoubleFeature" to the Youth Film Jury and Community Outreach Programs, Flickers has brought live performances, great films and interviews with leading artists to live and television audiences for over 35 years.

The Flickers: Rhode Island International Film Festival™ is the largest festival in New England, screening 265 titles in six days with an attendance in 2015 topping 40,000, for year-round events. Films screened came from 54 countries and 34 states in the U.S. There were 73 World Premieres and North American Premieres. RIIFF is considered "One of the most exciting festivals to come along," says Chris Gore in the Ultimate Film Festival Survival Guide. It is also a qualifying festival for the Short and Documentary Short Film Academy Awards through its affiliation with the Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences. Out of over 7,000 film festivals held worldwide, only 19 have this affiliation. RIIFF is the only festival in New England with this accolade. RIIFF is also one of only ten (10) Festivals in the United States that is a qualifier for the British Academy Awards (BAFTA).
